Sound attenuation level medium, Acoustic privacy is required.

The bathroom provides for assisted bathing of patients, patient dressing, undressing, grooming and handwashing. Facilities include a toilet, and handbasin; a separate shower within the room. A fixed island bath may be required depending on specialty, i.e. burns, paediatrics etc. If a fixed island bay is require a hydraulic lift bath may be considered for Health & Safety purposes. The bathroom should allow for manoeuvring of a patient on a lifting device or shower bed. Placement of the toilet should allow assistance from both sides. The room shall comply with AS1428.Additional Design Requirements: - The shower area must not have a raised hob. - The entrance to the bathroom is to be flush with the adjoining corridor.- The door is to be fitted with escape hardware- Bariatric capability may be considered, refer to project specific requirements. - Air-conditioning and exhaust should be intermittent use and operate when light switch is activated or turned off. Acoustics: Sound attenuation level - Medium. Acoustic privacy required. Body Protected electrical area
