The area and layout must accommodate an assisting nurse and a shower commode. The Ensuite and Bedroom should be planned as an integrated suite so the layout is optimised across the two rooms. Acoustics: Sound attenuation level - High. Acoustic privacy required. Body Protected Electrical Area Additional Design Requirements: - The shower floor must not have a raised hob - The entrance is to be flush with the adjoining flooring - The door is to be fitted with escape hardware
